### ... THE IDEA

Furthermore, secularism is embraced as a basic principle of organizing post-modern societies.

In this regard the alumni network aims at enabling professionals to become more competitive through working with public, social and corporate partners as well as network members. And while concentrating on the professional, let's not forget the personal - and the possibilities presented by this aspect of building international friendships across cultural and geographical divides.
